Terms and conditions of participation

Participation at the 36th IATA Ground Handling Conference (“the Conference”) is open to anybody duly registered. You must agree and adhere to these Terms and Conditions to participate to the Conference.

IATA and LIVE BY GL! EVENTS strive to provide a professional, respectful, and harassment-free event experience for everyone. We celebrate the diversity of all Conference Participants, exhibitors, and staff, and we expect every Participant to conduct themselves in a professional, respectful, and responsible manner at all times. By attending the event whether onsite or online, you are agreeing to respect and ensure a harassment-free event. If you engage in such behaviour, you may be asked to leave the event at the sole discretion of the event organisers.

You must not take part in any canvassing, leafleting, demonstrations, objectionable behaviour, or any activity, which may disrupt the Conference.

Smoking will only be permitted within the clearly designated smoking areas. Any fines for infringements of this ban shall be borne by the Participants.

IATA reserves the right to deny you participation in a specific session and/or to stop any activity on your part that may interfere with, or cause annoyance to other participants.

You must comply with the security requirements imposed by the venue and/or local/national authorities. You may not bring weapons (firearms and ammunition, knives, and sharp objects), easily flammable or explosive substances including pyrotechnics, drones, dogs (except guide dogs), gases or hazardous substances (including chemical pesticides and insecticides), or foul-smelling substances or radioactive sources. Other restrictions may apply.

You may not circulate with vehicles within the venue including un-motorised vehicles like bikes, scooters, etc.

IATA and LIVE BY GL! EVENTS (the “Organisers”) reserve the right to exclude or remove you from the Conference if you do not comply with these terms and conditions.

You are required to present a copy of an official identity card, passport, or another acceptable identification document to obtain your badge. The registration badge is the only onsite identification document needed during the entire period of Conference. It is personal to you and cannot be transferred to a third party. If you lose or forget your badge, you may not be allowed access to the Conference. You must report any lost badges to the reception/security.
