Videos must be submitted exclusively via the dedicated online platform.

## **Submission timeline**

# The video submission consists in

- **Video title**: Please choose a brief title that clearly indicates the content of the video. Please avoid abbreviations in the title. Abbreviations may be used in the text if they are defined when first used.
- Categories / Topics:

## Shoulder

- Rotator Cuff
- Instability
- Arthroplasty
- Fracture
- Basic Science
- Miscellaneous

#### **Elbow**

- Fracture
- Arthroplasty
- Soft tissue
- Basic Science





- **First author:** Name, email, institution, business affiliation (department, school, agency, or company, etc.), city and country. In instances of multiple authorship, the person whose name is listed first is expected to deliver the presentation.
- Co-authors: Names, email, institution/business information, country
- **Video summary**: should be written in English, concise and to the point, with a maximum length of 400 words

#### Video file:

- o to be uploaded in the platform
- o submissions should be original contributions to the field.
- o videos must be spoken in English and must include English subtitles
- o maximum duration: 6 minutes.
- o maximum 1 Go

## **Submission confirmation**

All submitters will receive a confirmation of submission by email. Your submissions can also be viewed in the "My submissions" section.

If you do not receive an e-mail confirmation, please check your online submission status. Make sure that you have access to the email address you have used at the time of submission.

# Video selection

Each video will be reviewed by members of the Education Committee and only those who meet the criteria listed above will be selected for presentation during the SECEC Annual Congress. The review process aims to assess the quality, relevance, and scientific merit of each submission.

The SECEC Education Committee will be solely responsible for selecting the videos that will be played at the Annual Congress.





The submitters will be notified the acceptance/rejection of their video by email.

Should your video be selected, it will be played in a dedicated video area of the exhibition hall. The audience will have the opportunity to vote for the two best videos (one shoulder and one elbow) via the congress app.

The two best videos will be included on SECEC's YouTube channel and promoted on SECEC social media after the congress. They will each receive a one free registration for the next Annual Congress.
